## CLEAN CAMPUS CHECKS JR. HIGH & MIDDLE SCHOOLS

All Jr. High and Middle schools will be judged during the week of January 29<sup>th</sup>-February 2<sup>nd</sup>. The final decisions are usually determined by recycling and reuse projects and programs along with hands-on student environmental efforts. A copy of the criteria is mailed to principals and made available to AB/C Campus Coordinators for each campus. The AB/C judge will want to speak with the AB/C Campus Coordinator during his/her visit. I suggest a written summary of your campuses environmental activities. The 1<sup>st</sup> place campus gets \$200 and the AB/C Clean Campus banner, 2<sup>nd</sup> place gets \$100, and third receives \$50. All prize money is to be used towards environmental efforts on campus.

### **ENERGY EFFICIENCY TIPS**
