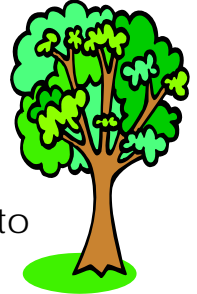
4th Grade "In the MOOD to Recycle" Pencils
