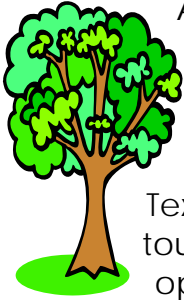
## "Litter Bugs Me" Bracelets 3rd GRADE
